Currently, due to COVID-19 restrictions/guidelines, the Center is closed except for the following essential services:

The <u>Senior Nutrition Lunch Program</u>, through FSA, is operating under a modified plan. Seniors desiring lunch service need to call the Center every Monday to reserve their lunches for the week. Pre-packaged meals will be distributed, drive-thru style, every Wednesday from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. A registration application must be completed prior to making a reservation.

<u>Feeding America Food Distribution</u> occurs on the first Thursday of each month. Call the Center on the first Tuesday to schedule your pick-up time. Food items will be distributed, drive-up style from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. While supplies last.

Cool/Warm Center

In partnership with the County of Riverside's Community Action Partnership, the Center will act as Cool/Warm Center for vulnerable seniors (Ages 55+) in need of temporary relief from the heat or cold, Monday – Friday from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., under certain weather conditions. When temperatures are forecast to exceed 97°F or 40°F, the Center will open following Social Distancing protocols. These protocols limit the number of participants to nine people at a time.
