

Step 1 - Create

- Grab a "shoe box" or something similarly inspiring - Start with a base like a box from a recent online order delivery, an old shoe box, a crate, a tub, or a container of choice. It doesn't have to roll. It just needs to be able to be "pulled" by string for the actual parade.
- Find your materials - Entries can be made from things you already have at home. You could use flowers from your yard, craft supplies, construction paper, dolls/action figures, paper mâché, clay, paint, markers, sequins, seeds, or anything else you can find to bring your float to life!
- Please follow a Veteran's Day theme; whether that be a historical parade float, telling a story, etc.
- Show us your progress - document the steps you take as you build your Veteran's Day Shoebox Parade float. Are you making marching band uniforms for your action figures - show us how! Are you making a butterfly float that flaps its wings - let us see how it works! Post progress pictures, tips and tricks, fun teases of your theme, or even bloopers on your social media and tag us #JARPDKeepingtheFunAlive or email to info@jarpd.org for a chance to be featured on J.A.R.P.D.'s social media.



Step 2 - Enter:

- **Submit your entry - fill out the registration form below and drop off your float and entry form between Nov. 2 – Nov. 4, 2020 at the Park District Office located at 8621 Jurupa Rd., Jurupa Valley, CA 92509. Hours: Mon– Fri, 8 AM—5 PM. Please call (951) 361-2090 to schedule an appointment to drop off your float.**
- Once you arrive for your appointed drop-off time, you will hand your float to a staff member. The staff member will then take your float to be filmed for the parade. This process will take up to 10 minutes, so it is highly encouraged you stay so that we may hand your float back to you once the filming of your float is complete.

Step 3 – Watch!

- Tell your friends and family to watch the parade and see your float featured in the J.A.R.P.D. Veteran's Day Shoebox Parade on Facebook on Wednesday, November 11, 2020.

Rules & Regulations

- Your float can be made from a traditional cardboard shoebox or similar structure (be creative).
- **Should be no larger than 9" x 13" and decorations on the box should not exceed 15" tall.**
- Veteran's Day Theme—Float must follow a Veteran's Day theme
- Entries and themes must be appropriate for a family audience. Entries should contain no political statement, slogan or reference. Use of any political or social material is not permitted.
- **All submissions must be received by 4PM on Wednesday, November 4, 2020.**
- Registration for the J.A.R.P.D. Veteran's Day Shoebox Parade and/or tagging #JARPDKeepingtheFunAlive with related photos or videos on social media grants the Park District permission to use your images and footage on any platform.
- Jurupa Area Recreation & Park District reserves the right to exclude any submissions that do not meet our guidelines or that feature content not aligned with our mission.
